
Ranganna Scrúduithe Stáit (BI.3 agus BI.6)

- 4th - 6th Years are allowed go to the shop at lunchtime but this is a special privilege which will be withdrawn from any student for speaking English or through poor behaviour.

Attendance & Punctuality

Punctuality has improved over the last year –we thank you for your support in getting the students to school on time. If a student is late, the school must be contacted by phone or a note provided in the student’s journal from a parent / guardian explaining why the student is late (save where specific arrangements have been made). If a student is in hospital / at the GP, dentist or some such, then a note / certificate must be provided from that centre. We urge parents/guardians to be less lenient in allowing students to go home when they aren’t too sick.

Gaeilge in the School

- Only Irish is permitted as the ordinary language of communication in the school.
- As you are aware, the steps system has been modified this year. The system is working well and a lot of Irish can now be heard around the school. We appreciate the support of parents/guardians in this regard.

Mobile Phones

As regards the students’ phones, we remind you that they must turn them off when they arrive on the school grounds and if they need to contact home for any reason during the day, they can only do that through the school secretary’s office.

School Self-Evaluation

We did very well with the school self-evaluation last year with significant improvements in the identified areas of numeracy and literacy. As part of this year’s SSE strategy, the school is undertaking (i) mathematical skills, (ii) language skills and (iii) wellbeing.

Christmas House Exams

The house exams took place from 4 - 8 December. There was some flexibility with regard to 6th Years (exams or teaching blocks). As usual, results will be posted home before Christmas.

Vaccinations

Various vaccines are being administered by the HSE to 1st Year students. The HSE visited the school on the 12 October and the following vaccines were given that day:

- Girls: the first dose of the HPV (for cervical cancer) and Tdap
- Boys: Tdap

Later in the year, those girls will receive the second dose of the HPV as well as the MenC vaccine and the boys will be given the MenC vaccine on that date too. It is concerning, however, that so few of the girls received the HPV vaccine.

Our students have been participating in a wide range of events this year. We congratulate the Senior Girls Basketball Team and their coach, Mr. Ó Catháin, on reaching the final during December.

New Junior Cycle

The junior cycle framework is changing incrementally over the course of a few years. Our 3rd Year students are taking English under the new framework. 2nd Year students are taking English and Science as well the optional subject, Business Studies while 1st Year students are

also taking those subjects under the new framework as well as Gaeilge, French/German and the optional subject, Visual Art. Wellbeing is also on the curriculum for 1st year students. The JCPA award (Junior Cycle Profile of Achievement Award) was presented recently to our TY students. As well as the mark that the students receive in their terminal exam (the old Junior Certificate), the JCPA also acknowledges the students' achievements in the classroom-based assessments, in any short courses undertaken and other areas of learning.


State Examination Classes (3rd and 6th Years)
